Please accept this letter as testimonial to the experience of installing a Continuous Disinfection Device (CDD) in my Dental Practice in Landisville, Pennsylvania.

The CDD installation took 4 days to complete and was affixed to the rafters in the attic of my building. Aesthetically, because the unit is hidden in the attic, the only difference in my practice is the addition of air registers for the supply and return air from the CDD. The unit has been operational now for two months.

The CDD operates continuously, 24/7/365 which gives me peace of mind that myself, my staff, and my patients are always protected. Prior to installing a CDD, I researched the disinfection marketplace and the various products offered. For me, I liked that the CDD was not an add-on to existing infrastructure. For example, some of the competitive products include UVC lamps placed in existing HVAC ductwork which runs intermittently (regulated by thermostat) and relies on airflow not necessarily optimized for ultraviolet disinfection. Other competitive products do not offer significant volumes of disinfected air and/or only work in individual rooms or limited spaces. The CDD offered the disinfection power, the voluminous airflow, and the continuous operation to properly protect my practice.

Since the installation and continuous operation of the CDD, my staff has been less reluctant to come to work and less worried about exposure to the coronavirus. While they have not overtly stated it, I think it really resonated with my staff as me caring for and investing in them. The unit has been operating silently and has caused no disruption to my normal business.

Moving forward, I plan on implementing a post installation marketing strategy to alert my patients and the public at large as to the benefits of CDD and the protection it provides my practice. I expect that, as news spreads about my protected practice, I'll benefit from increased referrals and associated revenue.

It is my hope that proprietors across all industries consider the CDD as an avenue to restore business and a sense of normalcy to their lives.
